### EXCITING BHP NEWS!

We have exciting news! BHP is holding two new monthly lotteries open to all residents of BHP properties.

**Lottery 1 - Pay your BHP balance on time and be automatically entered to win one month of free rent!** Starting April 2024, BHP will run a monthly lottery to reward one lucky resident with a free month of rent.

To enter the lottery:

1. Residents need to owe \$0 to BHP, and
2. Have an on-time payment record for at least the last six months

**Lottery 2 - Renew your lease for a full year and enter to win one month of free rent!** Renew your lease and get a chance to win! Starting April 2024, BHP will run a separate monthly lottery to reward residents who renew their lease for a full year.

To enter the lottery:

1. Residents need to renew their lease for one year
2. Owe \$0 to BHP, and
3. Be in good standing with their lease.

You can become a winner by renewing your lease for a full year!

That's it! BHP is looking forward to rewarding our first on-time payment and our first lease renewal lottery winners next month!

#### Did you know that you can use SNAP benefits at Boulder County Farmers Markets?

Swipe your EBT card at the information tent to get SNAP bucks to purchase SNAP eligible foods anywhere in the market. For every dollar you withdraw from your SNAP account, you will receive an equal amount of Double Up Bucks which can be used to buy fresh fruits and vegetables up to \$20 per visit. Just visit the information booth to receive your Double Up currencies!

#### Food Tax Rebate

The City of Boulder provides rebates to help compensate low-income residents for the city sales tax they pay on food. Those eligible to apply for the rebate include seniors 62 and older individuals with disabilities, and families with children under 18. Rebates for 2024 will be \$104 for individuals and \$318 for families. Applications are available at the BHP office, the W.
